

## COVID-19 POLICIES

1. IF YOU ARE SICK or think you may have been exposed, STAY HOME! You must notify our staff if you start showing symptoms, especially if you have been at the barn within the previous 10 days. This will allow us to do a thorough disinfection and warn others who may have been exposed.
2. We're committed to frequent cleaning and disinfecting of our common areas, but we ask that you do not congregate in groups. THE LOUNGE AND LOFT ARE CLOSED, UNLESS YOU NEED TO MAKE A PAYMENT or conduct specific business. The rosters have been hung outside in the aisle for easy access in the fresh air.
3. Wash your hands frequently. Do not touch your face.
4. Wear gloves and a mask while at the barn and wash them when you get home.
5. If you are unable to attend lessons due to the Coronavirus, contact Mary Ann to extend the expiration on your lessons.
