COVID-19 POLICIES

1. If you are sick or think you may have been exposed, STAY HOME! You must notify management, Mary Ann or Michala, if you start showing symptoms, particularly if you have been at the barn within the previous 10 days. This will allow us to do a thorough disinfection and warn others who may have been exposed.

2. MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES, BY EVERYONE, WHILE ON THE PROPERTY.

3. Non-riders are not permitted to enter the barn unless making a payment. If you're not comfortable sending your child in the barn alone please let your instructor know and they or a working student will greet you at the entrance of the barn when it is time to bridle.

3. **Do not enter the barn until your lesson time** as to avoid an overcrowded aisle during lesson change over. **Please leave the aisle as soon as your lesson is done** and you have finished cleaning your tack; do not "hang out" to socialize after your lesson.

4. We're committed to frequent cleaning and disinfecting of our common areas, but we ask that you do not congregate in groups. The lounge and loft areas are closed unless you need to make a payment or conduct specific business. The rosters have been hung outside in the aisle for easy access.

5. Please wash your hands frequently. Do not touch your face.

6. Wear gloves while at the barn touching common surfaces and wash them when you get home.

7. Please read all signs while in the barn and keep an eye out for any signs deeming an area closed or off limits; for ex. loft, office, observation decks, etc.
